• No changes to the team composition allowed post-deadline.

Team Formation

- Each team must consist of 2-4 members.
- Interdisciplinary and cross-domain teams are encouraged.
- One person cannot participate in more than one team.
- Teams must remain constant throughout the hackathon duration.

Problem Statement Categories

The problem statements will be announced on April 16, 2025.

% Rules & Regulations

- 1. All work must be done during the 48-hour window.
- 2. Participants can use open-source libraries and APIs.
- 3. Plagiarism or pre-built projects will lead to disqualification.
- 4. Teams must be physically present at the venue.
- 5. Use of AI tools like ChatGPT/Copilot is allowed for guidance but not for entire code generation.
- 6. Respect fellow participants, organizers, and mentors.
- 7. Teams are required to demo their solution in front of a panel of judges.
